



Content Development Process

Exit-Writer content is developed in-house by the Krames Content Development team. For over 30 years, the Krames Editorial, Content and Design, and Production teams have been instrumental in maintaining our market leadership position in health, wellness and patient education content. Currently, we employ 60 full-time professionals dedicated to the editorial management, research, review, writing, medical and artistic illustration, quality assurance, design production, manufacturing, inventory management, and IT support of our products for print and electronic content formats.

We have a team of experienced product editors who monitor content areas and specialties, research, conceive, plan, and propose new and revised products and who provide their expert advice from the product idea stage through the entire product development process. The editors also work closely with the writers, illustrators, and designers to develop market-appropriate products. The editors are responsible for developing strategic short-term and long-range plans for their specialty publishing programs keeping in mind key clinical developments, guideline changes and practice trends.

We have an in-house staff of medical writers who are members of the American Writers Association and produce original manuscripts based on primary research provided by our Library department. Our writers are chosen for their ability to produce clear, accurate text that is easily accessible to the average reader. Our writers go through a rigorous interview and testing process. Once hired, they are educated in the Krames brand of instructional design. We also have a full-time Medical Editor, a graduate of Johns Hopkins School of Public Health, who reviews every piece of content for readability and accuracy and is part of the project team.

Armed with the new content, our in-house staff of medical illustrators, lifestyle illustrators, and designers creates and produces medical and realistic illustration for all of our products. Each medical illustrator has a Masters in Medical Illustration and is a member of the Association of Medical Illustrators.

Our editorial team works closely with outside medical consultants and reviewers. These healthcare professionals, many of whom are at the forefront of their medical specialty, are chosen for their clinical and technical expertise on the topic at hand. On average, eight to twelve medical professionals will review content during three stages of the development process. Our professional reviewers not only validate the science but they also ensure that our content reflects the patient experience; that the content addresses the concerns of today's patient. This last point is a key differentiator for Krames. In addition to our 20+ emergency medicine specific reviewers – Krames has over 3,000 professional reviewers available.

After products are created, content is reviewed on an annual basis to ensure it reflects the latest science and practice standards. We draw upon our reviewer database to provide these reviews. As required by our reviews, content is updated.
